We believe in building a solid foundation for kids from the youngest age possible. Leaders will intentionally weave Biblical truths, Bible stories, songs, and other gospel-centered activities into the normal rhythm of their time spent with the preschoolers.

This will enable our babies and early childhood aged kids to experience the gospel in a clean and safe environment while being rocked or fed, participating in playtime, or engaging in other fun activities.

Elementary children will learn the story of the Bible through a 3-year chronological plan. Each story taught includes a visual timeline of the Bible, a map of Israel, and a fun activity to bring the story to life.

Small groups are led by intentional leaders who will build relationships with kids, discuss the Bible story, and pray with the kids. Our Kids Small Groups align with our Adult Small Groups format to include a Biblical Foundation, Intentional Leader, Relational Environment, and Reproducible Process.

Every session will point kids to the Gospel of Jesus Christ as the source of heart transformation and the foundation of spiritual growth. Kids will learn that the Bible is one big story about Jesus, while experiencing the Gospel through the love of their leaders.

We are intentional to create a safe, fun, and engaging environment where your LiferKids thrive!





LiferAbilities—our Real Life Kids special needs ministry—exists to share the love of Christ by assisting individuals and families needing special accommodations to become full participants and contributors in the body of Christ. With support available for children and families, we are committed to providing a safe and comfortable environment that allows all members access to worship, ministry, and fellowship with one another.

REAL LIFE SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY (AGES 4-12)

Our goal is to integrate children into an age-appropriate Real Life Kids class with the right level of assistance. If the need is identified, we do have a LiferAbilities classroom during one service and are happy to discuss this option with families interested as space allows.

TEEN ACCOMMODATIONS (AGES 12+)

Students meet together Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights at designated times. We do our best to partner with families to accommodate and integrate children with special needs into our normal activities with the right level of assistance. As God adds passionate and qualified leaders to our team, we can expand this effort together.

What to Expect

Check-In

Before service each week, the Kid Connect Team will be there to greet you and assist with checking your child in. Both you and your child will receive a set of stickers with a matching code, also known as a "security tag". This sticker is what you'll use to pick up your child(ren) after the service. If we need to reach you for any reason, we'll text or call you using the phone number on you child's name tag.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up

Once your child is checked in and arrives at the room printed on their sticker, our leaders will be ready to greet your family. At the end of service, a team member will verify that your security tag code matches the code on your child's tag before he/she is released into your care. In the event of a lost sticker, we will use your photo identifications as an alternative to the security tag to verify information and check out your child.

Small Groups

Your child will be taught age-specific, biblical truths and practical lessons through a learning plan and collection of topics throughout the year.

The learning plan for your child's specific age will be taught and discussed in relational Small Groups by their leader on **Sunday mornings** and **Wednesday nights.** Each week in their Small Group, they will work together to get to know one another more, rebuild the Bible story, discuss questions, and pray. Our Kids Small Groups model after our Adult Small Groups to live out a practical disciple-making method that aligns with the message and method of Jesus.

Learn Plan

We believe that scripture should not be injected into topics, but rather topics and lessons should be pulled from the context of scripture. Therefore, in all our curriculum we choose biblically based storying that kids learn over a multi-year cycle that focuses on how the gospel and Jesus is threaded throughout all of scripture. We teach stories from Genesis to Revelation chronologically to help children understand the full picture of God's Word.

We are a church committed to follow Jesus' method as we share His message. This starts with our kids!

Safety

In Real Life Kids, we are committed to safety, and it is the heart of our children's ministry to make every effort to ensure the safety and well-being of every child.

With this in mind, we do not allow anyone to pick up a child without a corresponding security tag. In addition, all team members serving in a Kids area go through a screening process and are trained in safety and security protocols before serving. Kids Leaders are all required to check-in and have a printed name tag before entering the Kids areas.

Once in our care, a child is not allowed to be picked up by anyone who does not have a security tag with the code that coincides with the one on his/her sticker. Any adults entering the Kids area must show either a pick-up sticker or be wearing a Leader name tag before entering the hallway.

In addition, we have cameras in each classroom and access controlled doors that secure the kids hallways during the service. All of this is in effort to do our part to keep your child safe!

- Mothers Room: The Mothers Room is equipped with chairs and changing stations. Mothers may comfortably view the service via live stream while they tend to their infants or small children. To respect everyone's privacy, these rooms are for mothers only. The women's restroom is connected to the Mothers Room!
